- Find ways for humans to protect endangered species.

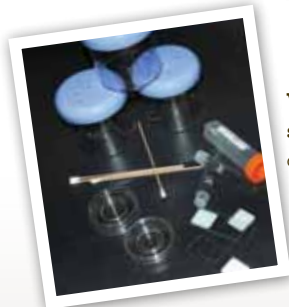


Tools of the Trade
