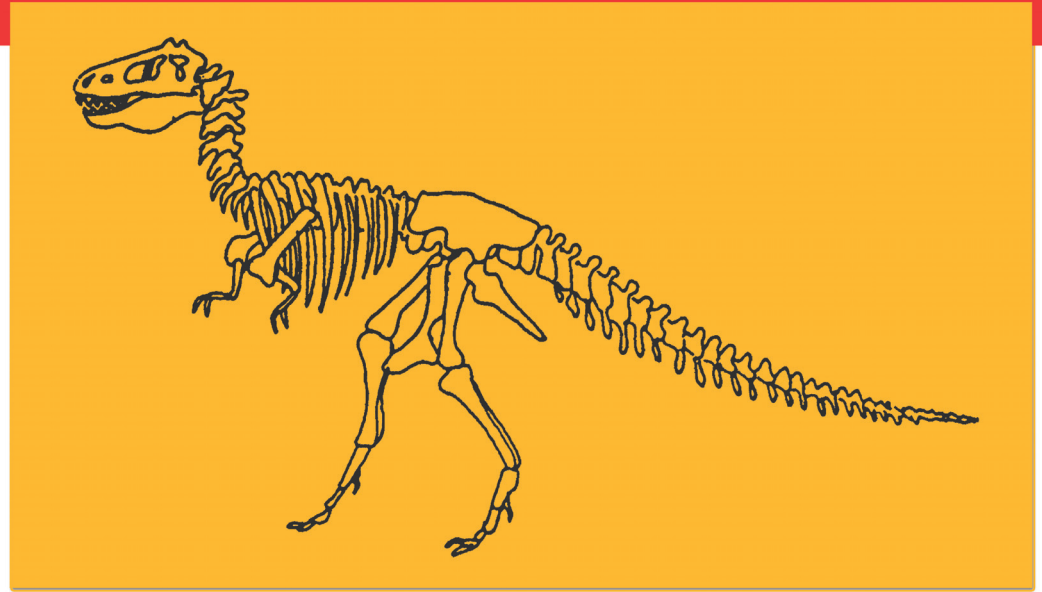


# DINOSAUR PUZZLER

Paleontologists (scientists who study fossils) rarely find complete dinosaur skeletons with each bone in its proper place. Through careful research, they have to decide where each bone fits. You can try the same thing. Cut out each group of bones. Then use the skeleton pictured as a pattern to help you reassemble the entire dinosaur. First, lay the bones out on another piece of paper. Once you have them in the right place, glue them down. Can you guess what kind of dinosaur this is?



**Answer:**  
It's a large meat-eater like *Tyrannosaurus Rex* or *Albertosaurus*. You can see a "fleshed-out" model of a T-Rex in the Museum's permanent exhibition *A Walk Through Time in Georgia*.
